# Who can participate?

- Open to all barangays under the Bitan-ag Creek Rehabilitation Project
  - Indahag, Lapasan, Camaman-an, Nazareth, Puntod, Barangays 22, 24, 26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 33, 35 & 36

# Objectives

- Encourage every barangay to participate in the rehabilitation of Bitan-ag Creek and to comply with related environmental laws.
- Promote participatory development through social mobilization in the barangay



# Mechanics and Guidelines

- The challenge is open to all barangays along and drains to Bitan-ag Creek;
- The challenge shall commence on October 15 and will run until November 25, this year;
- All participating barangays shall be treated and will be evaluated as such regardless of the financial status, area and number of residents;

- The participating barangays shall design program/project that promotes social mobilization and greater participation of local residents related to:
  - solid waste management
  - creek management
  - community-based education & advocacy campaign;
- Passage of a resolution/Ordinance to institutionalize the program

- Any interested barangay shall submit its written manifestation signed by the Barangay Chairman to be recognized as official entry;
- Written manifestation shall be submitted on or before October 15, 2015 to Patrick U. Gabutina, Hapsay Sapa Coordinator;

- Pre-evaluation will be conducted by the panel of judges prior to the final judging on November 25, 2015 ;
- The panel of judges shall be selected by Hapsay Sapa Council;
- Winning program/project design shall be awarded with PhP 500,000 for its implementation.
