Car sharing

The City is working with [Modo the Car Co-op](#) (formerly the Co-operative Auto Network) to provide a [centralized pool of vehicles](#) that can be booked by City staff working at City Hall campus as well as at other work locations. In addition, all City staff, regardless of work location, can sign up for [personal use](#).

Getting a car share vehicle for work (City Hall campus)

There are a number of Modo cars as well as City-owned vehicles available at City Hall. To use these vehicles you must first register with Modo the Car Co-op. The one-time process to register includes providing your Driving Record and Claims History to the Car Co-op. Once registered it is easy to book the vehicles and you will have access to an entire fleet of cars. [Click here to find out how to register and use the cars.](#)

A number of City-owned cars are available through the new car share program for staff who require marked vehicles or who do not meet the driving record criteria for using the Modo cars, as well as to provide a buffer in case all the Co-op cars are booked.

Getting a Modo car for personal use

All City staff, including those who work outside of the City Hall campus, can get a discounted personal account for Modo the Car Co-op and access both the vehicles parked at City Hall and the Modo's entire network throughout the region for personal use. Please note that if you plan to sign up for both a work and a personal account you'll only have to go through the driver's check and orientation process once.

Benefits of the new car sharing program

- All City Hall campus employees have timely and convenient access to cars for meetings or field work.
- All City employees can get discounted personal accounts for Modo the Car Co-op. This gives you access to their entire network of vehicles throughout the region at any time.
- With personal accounts, employees also have access to Modo cars for personal needs while at work, such as medical appointments and lunchtime errands.
- The community benefits as well. On evenings and weekends when the Modo cars aren't being used by City employees, members of the public who have Modo the Car Co-op memberships are able to use them.



New Electric Car Share Vehicle

Car Share members. If you're not a Car Share member, it's easy to sign up.
