Davis Street Improvement Project Resumes July 7

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Over the next six weeks, the City of Evanston will complete the remaining contract work for the Davis Street Improvement Project. Beginning the week of July 7, the City's contractors will first install pavement markings, followed by a protected bike lane on Davis St. (from Ridge to Hinman Avenues) similar to the one on Church St.

The actual date of construction will be noted on the temporary NO PARKING signs, posted 48 hours prior to the start of work. Daytime NO PARKING restrictions will be intermittent throughout the duration of the construction project. However, evening and night time parking (5 p.m. to 7 a.m.) will be available with the exception of a few nights.

The City will be mindful of its construction activities and work to minimize any inconveniences caused by this project. Construction is expected to be completed by the week of August 11.

Area businesses and residents are reminded to use legal street parking spaces on adjacent side streets and parking garages during this time. Additionally, when temporary daytime NO PARKING is in effect, street sweeping and neighborhood parking restrictions will be waived for a one-block radius around the construction zone.

Contractor

The contractor for this street improvement project is Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc., 225 Telser Rd., Lake Zurich. The contractor is contractually responsible for the means and methods of the work.
