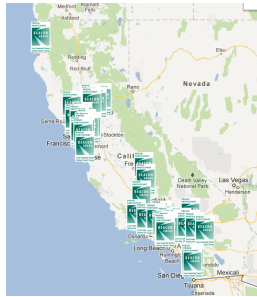

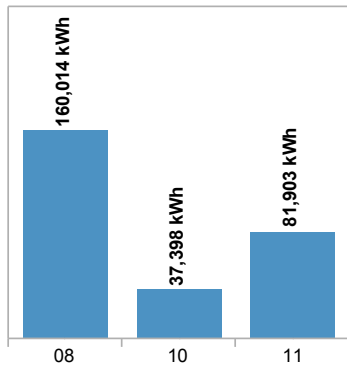
This report outlines energy savings data as required by the Beacon Award program for recognition purposes.

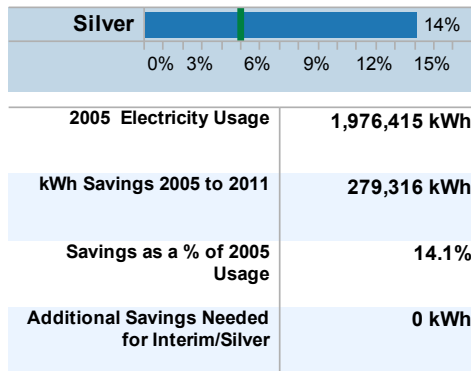

Project kWh Savings

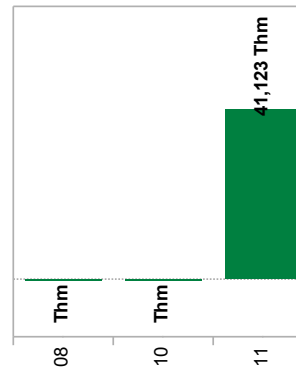


Municipal kWh Savings criteria

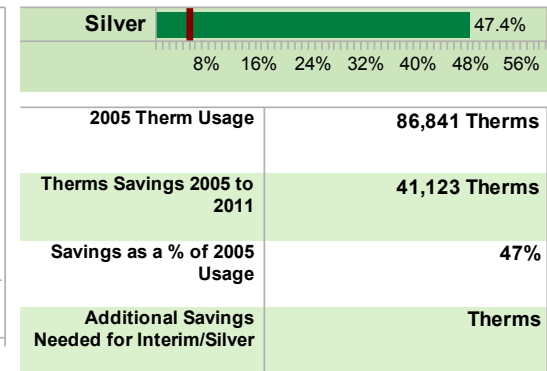


Interim Recognition Eligible

Project Therm Savings

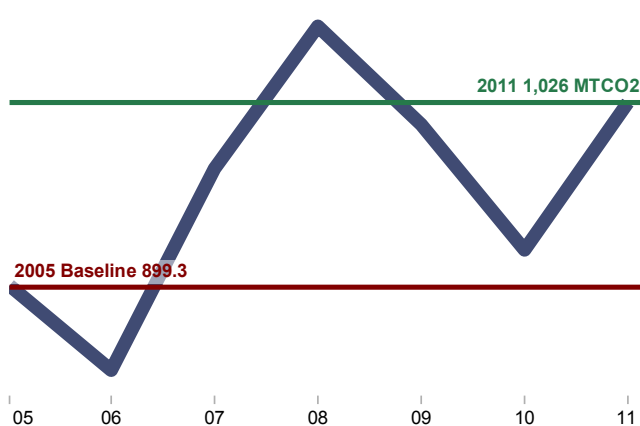


Municipal Therm Savings Criteria

Municipal Energy Related Emissions

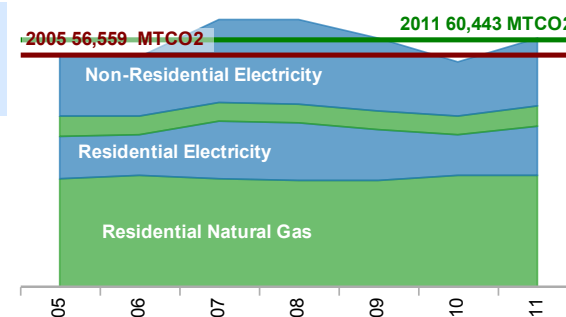
