BYLAW NO. 6760

A Bylaw to authorize the use of low speed electric powered vehicles on public highways

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of Delta, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1 In this Bylaw,

"Municipality" means the geographic area within the boundaries of The Corporation of Delta;

"neighbourhood zero emission vehicle" means a vehicle that travels on 4 wheels and is powered by an electric motor that is designed to allow the vehicle to attain a speed of 32 kilometres per hour but not more than 40 kilometres per hour in a distance of 1.6 kilometres on a paved level surface, and which

- (1) meets or exceeds standards of the *Motor Vehicle Safety Act* (Canada) for a low-speed vehicle and bears a compliance label for a low-speed vehicle in accordance with that Act; or
- (2) if imported to Canada, has been imported as an admissible low-speed vehicle in accordance with the *Motor Vehicle Safety Act* (Canada) requirements and
 - (a) bears a compliance label for a low-speed vehicle in accordance with that Act; or
 - (b) meets applicable federal United States laws in accordance with the *Motor Vehicle Safety Act* (Canada).

"vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in the Motor Vehicle Act, RSBC 1996 c. 318, as amended or replaced from time to time.

- 2 A person may drive or operate a neighbourhood zero emission vehicle on any highway within the Municipality that has a speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour or less.
- 3 The authority conferred by Section 2 is in addition to the authority under Section 24.07(3)(a) of the *Motor Vehicle Act Regulations*, B.C. Reg. 26/58, as

amended, for a person to drive or operate a neighbourhood zero emission vehicle on a highway that has a speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour or less.

4 This Bylaw may be cited as the **Neighbourhood Zero Emission Vehicle** Authorization Bylaw 6760, 2009.
