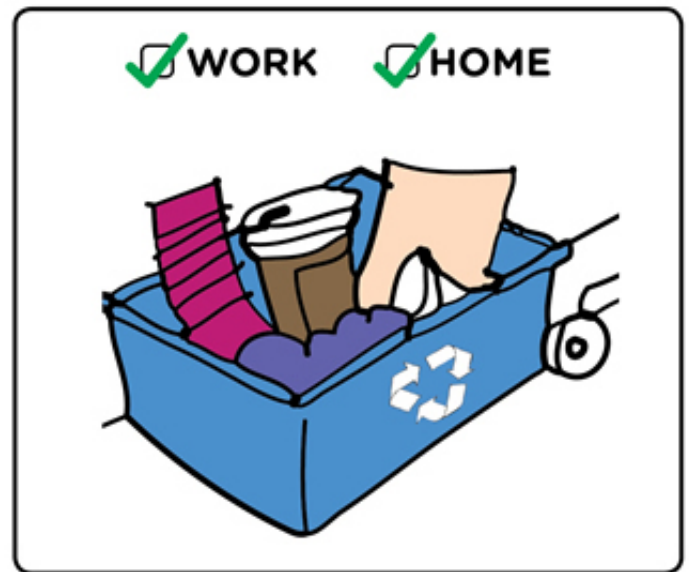


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Expanded recycling coming soon to your workplace



**There are some things you can only do at home.
Recycling isn't one of them!**



The City is committed to leading the way on green issues through our own operations and inspiring others to adopt sustainable waste management practices.

When the program launches at each workplace from now through 2013, we'll replace the waste containers at all desks with a single blue desk container (recycling container) that you will be required to empty at a central zero waste station. View [launch dates](#).

1. Paper
2. Mixed plastic containers (coffee cup lids)
3. Soft plastics (plastic film wrap)
4. Organics (fruit, bread, meat, pizza crusts, noodles)
