An IT Department solution to help us green City operations

What is Green Desktop?

With the Green Desktop program your computer will be put to sleep after 20 minutes of inactivity. This simple step saves energy, reduces costs and helps lower the City's climate-altering greenhouse gas emissions.

You have saved the City \$17,893 by using your Green Desktop.

Since going live in March, the Green Desktop has saved the City **295,754 kWh** of energy which translates into **\$17,893** in savings. If we keep this up, over the course of a year the City will save over **\$35K**, consume 500 MWh less electricity and reduce C02 emissions by 12 metric tonnes. See graph below for more detail and check back every month for updates.

If you use VPN to remote control your desktop computer at work, please e-mail the <u>Help Centre</u> to provide your computer's decal number, and ask that your computer to be added to the VPN power exemption group.

Help IT manage your computer by restarting it at the end of the day and turning off you monitor before you go home.

- **NO NEED** to wait for the restart to finish
- **DO NOT** turn your desktop off
- **DO NOT** leave computer applications running overnight unless they are in use
