


Where do our GHG's come from?

2008 Community GHG Emissions





WHAT IS THE FINANCING OFFER?

Vancity Loan Offer Terms

Amount: \$4,000-\$16,000

Preferred Rate: 4.5%* fixed

Term: 10 years

WHO DOES THE WORK? TWO OPTIONS

Direct Install Option

- Hire a pre-approved contractor (HELP pays contractor; homeowner repays loan quarterly)
- End to end service

Self-Serve Option

- Pay a contractor (receive HELP loan in advance; pay for work; repay loan quarterly) and/or
- Do-it-yourself (receive HELP loan in advance; repay loan quarterly)
- Manage Your Own Home Energy Upgrades

1. HOME ENERGY AUDIT



Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Schedule ecoENERGY audit (list of auditors available: vancouver.ca/energyloan)
- Auditor visits home and conducts energy audit
- Auditor provides report on home's energy efficiency, list of recommended upgrades including those covered in Home Energy Loan Program
- Select which upgrades to undertake
- Complete Home Energy Loan Program
 Participation Agreement with auditor
 (available: vancouver.ca/energyloan, City
 Hall or from auditor)

2. LOAN APPLICATION & APPROVAL





Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Gather documents required to apply for loan (checklist available: vancity.com/loans/homeenergy, from auditor or vancouver.ca/energyloan)
- Begin loan qualification process with Vancity:
 Online: vancity.com/loans/homeenergy Phone: local 604.648.5195 or toll free 866.648.5195 In person: at any Vancity branch, by appointment
- · Vancity notifies you of loan qualification status
- Note: once loan is approved, you must complete upgrade work and post-upgrade ecoENERGY audit within 90 days


Self Serve Option:

Manage Your Own Home Energy Upgrades

- Steps as Direct Install Option
- Visit Vancity branch to sign loan documentation and receive funds
- Begin repaying loan on quarterly basis through City of Vancouver utility billing



3. CONTRACTOR QUOTES & SELECTION



Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Request quote(s) from list of pre-approved contractors
- Select contractor and sign agreement to proceed with upgrade work

Self Serve Option:

Manage Your Own Home Energy Upgrades

- Do work yourself or
- Request quote(s) from contractor(s) of your choice
- Select contractor(s) to proceed with upgrade work

4. HOME IMPROVEMENT UPGRADES



Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Contractor completes energy efficiency upgrades
- You and contractor sign Letter of Completion confirming satisfactory completion of upgrades

Self Serve Option:

Manage Your Own Home Energy Upgrades

- Contractor(s) completes energy efficiency upgrades
- Pay contractor(s)



5. POST-UPGRADE ENERGY AUDIT



Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Schedule post-upgrade audit with ecoENERGY auditor
- Auditor inspects and approves upgrades have been completed to meet Home Energy Loan Program standards by signing Letter of Completion
- Auditor will submit paperwork for relevant rebates on your behalf

Self Serve Option:

Manage Your Own Home Energy **Upgrades**

- Schedule post-upgrade audit with ecoENERGY auditor
- Auditor will submit paperwork for relevant rebates on your behalf

6. LOAN REPAYMENT & COST SAVINGS



Direct Install Option:

End-to-End Service

- Submit Letter of Completion to Vancity
- Vancity pays contractor directly on your behalf
- Enjoy increased home comfort and save money on your energy bills
- Pay loan on quarterly basis through City of Vancouver quarterly utility billing

Self Serve Option:

Manage Your Own Home Energy Upgrades

 Enjoy increased home comfort and save money on your energy bills



FOR EXAMPLE...

Total Retrofit Cost \$11,250

Grants Available - \$3,700
Net Cost (Loan size) \$7,550

Annual Energy Savings \$755

Annual Loan Payment \$755
(\$188 quarterly)

Years 1 - 1 0
