## O Low Carbon Plus Apartment Construction Project

- Because of global warming issues caused by greenhouse gases emitted in everyday life and the consequences of climate change, proactive measures against greenhouse gases are required.
- Based on the master plan on climate change of Wonju City Hall, about half of greenhouse gases are emitted by households and businesses.
   Practical reduction programs are needed to reduce greenhouse gases from apartments given their prevalence.
- Wonju should control global warming as a pilot city for climate change response. To this end, organized and specific greenhouse gas reduction programs are highly needed.
- As a city venture, the Low Carbon Plus Apartment Construction Project aims to effectively cut greenhouse gases at large-scale apartments with more potential to achieve reduction and establish a pilot complex.
