

Phasing out oil

The public housing company Uppsalahem, that build and rent apartments within the city of Uppsala, have since 2007 been working with phasing out the use of fossil fuel in energy production. In 2007 Uppsalahem had 35 facilities that used oil boilers and electric heaters. In 2012 only 3 oil boilers remain. Some of the facilities have been sold, but 24 of them have been transformed. The facilities now use district heating, local district heating, geothermal heating, pellet or different kinds of heat pumps instead.
